Affordable and efficient

French universities are known for their low tuition fees: most of them charge the same tuition fees to all students (i.e. 243 €/year for master training).

A welcoming environment

Students who have completed their Bachelor's degrees are eligible to apply for an MS in French universities.

Numerous French universities offer Master's programs in English. Master training includes internships in laboratories with widespread international connections, and therefore English-speaking.
