Such richness renders France an excellent destination for studying, working and living.

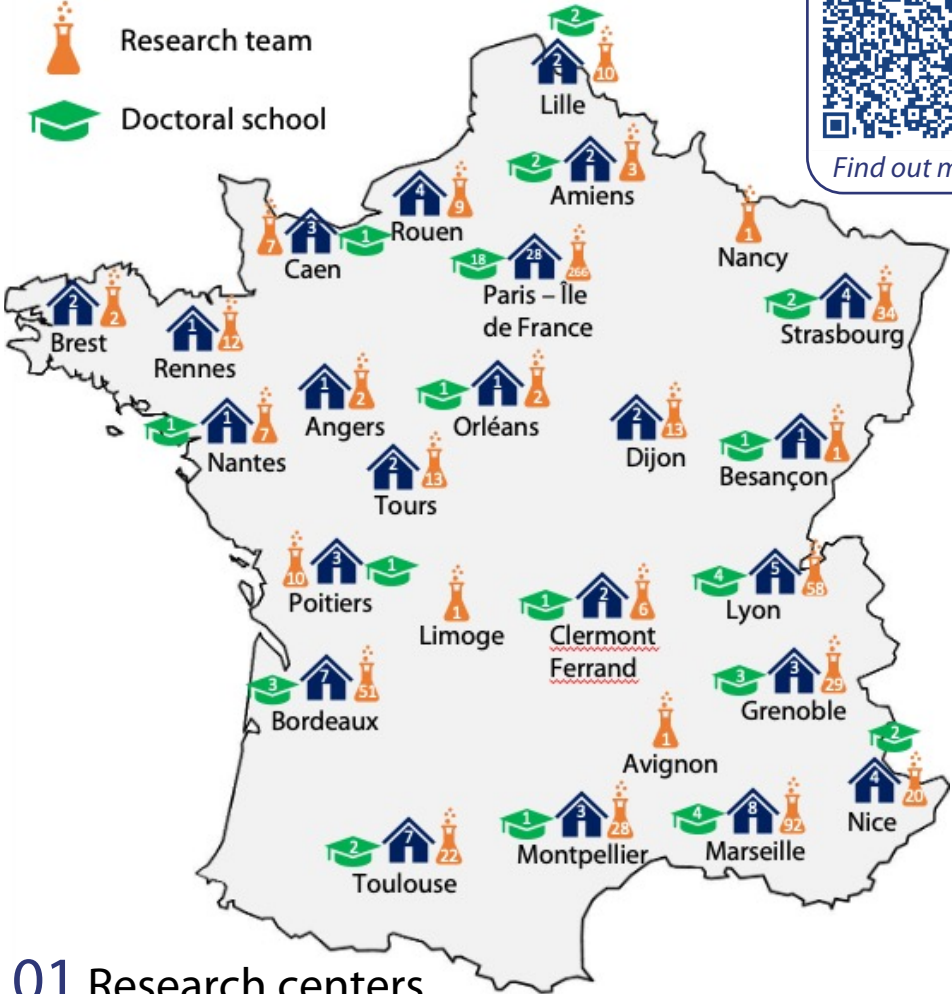
